Formation of the Cable System

1951

Trade association for US cable industry is formed:
National Cable & Telecommunications Association

1964

Charter starts cable operations in Alabama under the
name NewChannels

1973

Warner Communication starts Warner Cable

1979

Former Cox executives and NewHouse join hands
to form MetroVision

1981

NewHouse expands by acquiring Vision Cable

1989

Warner Communications and Time Inc. join to
form Time Warner Inc.

1992

Warner cable Join hands with American Television & Communications
to form Time Warner Cable

1993

Charter Communications, Inc comes to the surface
and starts acquiring cable systems nationwide

1994

Time Warner Entertainment partner with Advance/NewHouse for cable partnership

1998

Charter controlling interest acquired by Paul Allen

1999

Charter enters the stock exchange

2001

Charter makes its way into Fortune 500

2007

Time Warner Cable public trading on the New York Stock Exchange

2009

Chapter forces Charter to restructure finances
Time Warner Cable and Time Warner part ways

2012

Charter Appoint Thomas M. Rutledge ad President & CEO

2013

Charter gets Liberty Media and Spectrum is announced as a brand

2016

Charter, Time Warner Cable, and Bright House Networks join forces
